*Grenoble Ecole de Management invites applications for a full-time position in **strategy and/or technology management** with a research focus on strategy in the energy sector or energy technology management or corporate carbon management. (Starting date September 2015)*

Candidates should also demonstrate their ability to teach successfully for various levels and audiences and their willingness to be involved in the institution. A specific requirement for this position is the ability to reach out to business in the form of training courses, workshops and (applied) research. A good working knowledge of the French language would be a strong asset, but not a requirement.
