ADVANCED PH.D. SEMINAR IN MANAGEMENT

You are invited to apply to EMLYON's Ph.D. outdoor seminar in Chamonix.

A fantastic opportunity to get constructive feedback on your doctoral work, connect with great fellow PhDs and profs, and have the opportunity to ski the mythical Vallée Blanche!

Ph.D. students from European and US schools present their doctoral work and receive feedback from fellow students and professors. To make the most out of this experience, participants must send their full paper in advance and prepare reviews of other participants' papers.

Papers should focus on the participants' doctoral research. Both theoretical and empirical papers are welcome, as long as they are closely related to the dissertation topic. Students are welcome to use the opportunity to present their dissertation proposal.

Doctoral students and faculty members must read the papers that are assigned to them and prepare written comments.

We will spend one hour per paper, with a 10-minute presentation (which should take into account that participants have read the paper), and the remaining time devoted to comments and discussion.

Note that we fully expect everyone to stay for the entire duration of the seminar and to attend all sessions.

ACCOMMODATION AND TRAVEL

EMLYON Business School is paying for hotel and half-board for two nights in Chamonix, France. This means that those coming only for the seminar will have no expenses except traveling. Those wishing to stay longer and ski will be on their own.

We have reserved rooms in wonderful three-star Hotel Labrador in Chamonix (see www.hotel-labrador.com). Ph.D. students will share rooms with another student.

Travel arrangements to the seminar are to be made by participants themselves. Chamonix is easily reached by train, air, and land; check their website: www.chamonix.com. Should you want to stay longer, please book in advance.
