

## Call for papers for R&D Management Conference 2019

As a part of the R&D Management Conference that will be held in Paris on 19–21 June 2019 at École Polytechnique and HEC Paris, we are pleased to open the paper submission process.

While authors are expected to submit a full paper ahead of the conference, selection of papers accepted to be presented at the conference will be based on the submission of <u>500–1000</u> word structured abstracts (please read the <u>submission guidelines</u> carefully).

Submissions are now open through the <u>ConfTool platform</u> and will close on March 1st.

Relevant themes include all those covered in the past R&D Management conferences, as well as topics that closely relate to the main theme of the 2019 conference:

In particular, the following topics are of interest:

- Education for Innovation
- Innovation in Emerging countries and reverse Innovation
- Innovation spaces, such as Fab Labs, makerspaces and co-working spaces
- Innovation and regulation
- Energy transition and ecology

Following an earlier call (now closed), a number of Special Tracks have been selected for this year's conference. They have been grouped in 11 different themes:

- Theme 2: Co-creation, Creativity & Design
- Theme 3: Digital Technology
- Theme 4: Ecosystems
- Theme 5: Emerging Markets
- Theme 6: Radical and systemic innovation
- Theme 7: Industry 4.0
- Theme 8: Open Innovation
- Theme 9: Organizational & Marketing Innovation
- Theme 10: R&D
- Theme 11: Sustainable Development

In addition to these 11 tracks, papers can be submitted to a general track.

Submission of abstracts opens on February 1st and closes on March 1st.
